I have lived through too many wars.

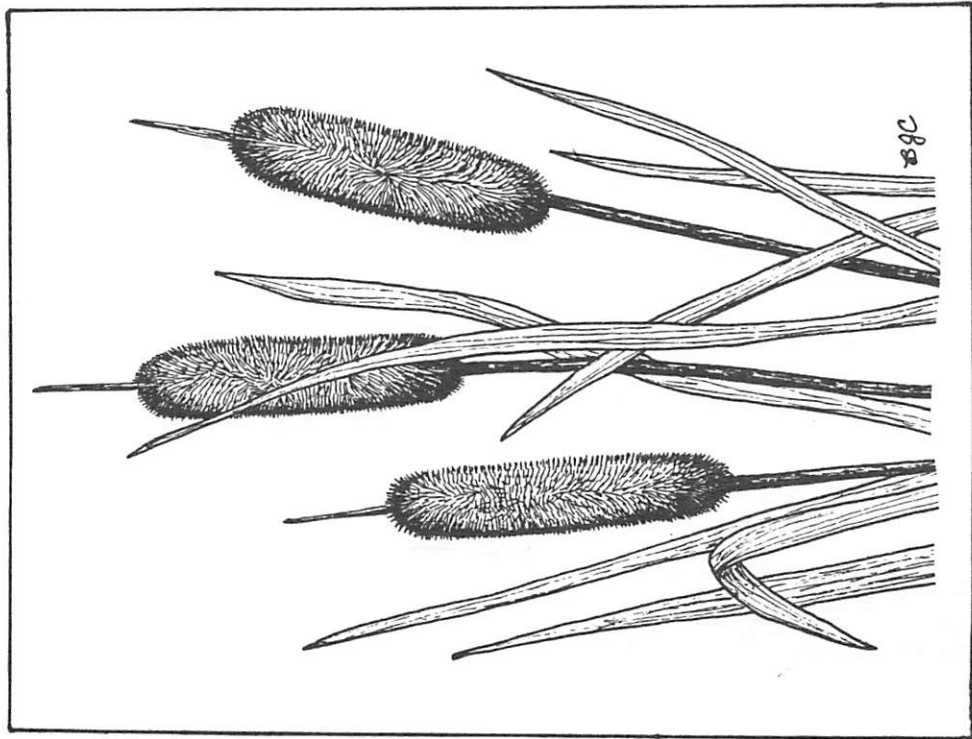
I want to see this book. We have an extra good county library branch here.
